Certificate of Eligibility & Recommendation

The Troop Committee may recommend one adult per 50 registered boys to the lodge adult selection committee (our lodge executive committee) and may do so only if the troop holds an election of eligible boys for the same year.

- Is a registered adult member of the Boy Scouts of America, 21 years of age or over.

The 15 days and nights included one, but no more than one, long-term camp consisting of six consecutive days and five nights of resident camping, approved and under the auspices and standards of the Boy Scouts of America. The balance of the camping was overnight, weekend or short-term camps.
